More importantly, these improvements are anchored on ensuring the safety of all park users, from employees and visitors to transport and logistics partners.

To date, the project is 81% complete, with full completion targeted by April 2. Works have been carefully scheduled to minimize disruption while maintaining efficiency and quality standards.

Beyond immediate repairs, this effort reflects Carmelray’s long-term vision of building sustainable, well-maintained environments that support business continuity and community well-being. By investing in infrastructure today, Carmelray reinforces its commitment to providing safe, reliable, and future-ready spaces for all.

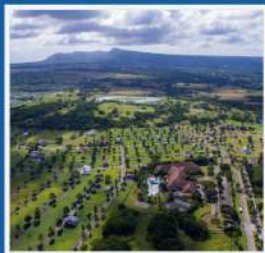
